Fees: Entire fee must be paid at registration - \$50 for children who do not attend the aftercare program, \$25 for children enrolled in aftercare. Exception: Fee for Babysitting is \$100 for children who do not attend aftercare, \$75 for students enrolled in aftercare. Students who do not attend after care on the day of the class, will remain at their school until the class begins. There is no need for the child to be picked up at dismissal time and returned to the school for the class.

Refunds: Unless the class is cancelled, course fees cannot be refunded once the class has begun. Prior to the first class, a request for refund may be made by email to: info@pway.org. A \$5 administration fee will be assessed. Refunds or credit will not be issued for missed classes.

Late Pick Up: If your child does not attend the aftercare program, please be sure to note the class start and end times. A late pick up charge of \$10.00 will be assessed for every 15 minutes, by the school clock, the child remains at the school after the enrichment class has dismissed.

Emergency and Inclement Weather Closing: When enrichment classes are cancelled, announcements will be posted at: piscatawayschools.org. Classes will be rescheduled so that children attend the full sessions.

Course Descriptions

Basketball: Dribble, pass and shoot as you develop skills to be successful at playing basketball. Box out your opponent and master your shots from the top of the key to three-pointers.



Karate: Explore martial arts at a comfortable level. Have fun learning basic self-defense techniques. No uniform required, just wear comfortable clothing.



Garden Club: Join our Garden Club and learn how to plant flowers and vegetables. Learn the basics of gardening while tending to our school garden. Safety and planting techniques will be taught.



Sewing: Students will get a basic introduction to sewing. They will learn different types of stitches, and how to use colorful embroidery threads to add flare to their creations.



Zumba: Perfect for younger Zumba fans! Classes feature kid-friendly routines based on original Zumba choreography, with added games and activities.



Bricks 4 Kidz: Use LEGO Bricks to create buildings and vehicles. Explore the principles of engineering, architecture, and physics to develop problem solving and critical thinking skills.



Cheering: Students will learn the basic fundamentals of cheer, along with a unique routine highlighting their skill level. Class will include: creative transitions, exciting dance sequences, and beginning fundamentals for stunts and pyramids.



Young Rembrandts: Budding artists will flex their creative muscle drawing a cute Jack Russell Terrier, all new Emojis, a ferocious T-Rex and more creative and fun drawings.



Babysitting Safety: *4/4, 4/18, 4/25, 3 sessions. Would you like to become a Super Safe Sitter? By attending this course you will learn how to properly care for and supervise children. Receive certification from the Amer. Safety & Health Inst. upon completion of the three week course.



Jr. First Responders: *3/30, 4/6, 4/20/ 4/27 & 5/4, 5 sessions. Learn the basics of CPR, First Aid and Fire Safety. Using guidelines provided by the Amer. Safety & Health Inst., students who complete the five week course receive 2-year certification cards and manuals for CPR and Basic First Aid. They'll also receive a certification of completion for fire safety.
