Course Information and Fees

Fun and Games: Students participate in a variety of interactive physical activities that will promote positive physical activity and fitness, good sportsmanship and working as a team. Activities will include rain, thunder, lightning, fire and ice; tag; soccer; hula hoop tag; scooter relays; castle ball and more! Fee: \$50.

Double Dutch: Learn the sport of Double Dutch – rope skipping when two ropes are turned in eggbeater fashion. With little or no experience, participants learn about rhythm, timing, and working together. The challenge is both mental and physical. Fee: \$50.

Cheering: Children will learn the basic fundamentals of cheer, along with a unique routine highlighting their skill level. Class will include: creative transitions, exciting dance sequences, and beginning fundamentals for stunts and pyramids. Fee: \$50.

Karate: Explore martial arts at a comfortable level. Have fun learning basic self-defense techniques. No uniform is required, just wear comfortable clothing. Fee: \$50.

Cartoon Drawing: Draw your favorite characters from pop culture and media, then create characters for your own stories. Fee: \$50.

Fun with Food: MMMMMMM. . . make sweet treats and bring them home with you. We'll measure, blend, and bake. It is a fun and interactive way to learn how to properly make delicious and simple treats at home. Fee: \$50.

CPR/AED for Infants, Children and Adults*: *One session, April 29, adults only, from 9am to 12noon.* Be prepared for the unexpected emergency. Designed for the lay rescuer, this one session course teaches Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation. Receive a two year certification from the American Health and Safety Institute upon completion of the three hour course. Fee: \$50.

Basketball: Dribble, pass and shoot as you develop skills to be successful at basketball. Box out your opponent and master your shots from the top of the key to three-pointers. Fee: \$50.

Elementary Drawing: Budding artists will flex their creative muscle as they draw a Jack Russell Terrier, all new Emojis, a ferocious T-Rex, and many more fun drawings. Fee: \$50.

Young Elementary Drawing: Expand preschoolers' imaginative thoughts all season long as they draw adorable ducks, a delicious pizza, a pirate ship and many more colorful lessons. Fee: \$50.
